

Destination

Bahrain

Bahrain, a nation comprising more than 30 islands in the Arabian Gulf, has been at the center of major trade routes since antiquity. In its modern capital, Manama, the acclaimed Bahrain National Museum showcases artifacts from the ancient Dilmun civilization that flourished in the region for millennia. The city's thriving Bab al-Bahrain bazaar offers wares ranging from colorful handwoven fabrics and spices to pearls

Climate

The climate of Bahrain is an arid type; mean annual rainfall is small (70.8mm) and irregular. Broadly speaking, the year may be divided into two main climatic periods from June to September and from December to March, separated by two transitional periods April/May and October/November.

The mean number of days per annum with measurable rain of 1mm or more are 9.9 with the highest being 2 days in the month of January. Thunderstorms occur on average on 7.8 days per annum with March having the highest

mean average of 1.9 days. The average number of days per annum that visibility is reduced to 1000 metres or less by fog is 6.6 and by thick dust haze is 4.5. January averages 1.7 days of fog, and is the highest monthly frequency. July has the highest frequency of thick dust haze occurrence (1.1 days on average).

Manama, the modern capital of the Arabian Gulf island nation of Bahrain, has been at the center of major trade routes since antiquity. Language

Arabic is the official language of Bahrain, but English is widely spoken. It is used in business and is a compulsory second language in schools.

The official currency of Dinar is the Bahraini Dinar (BHD). The Bahraini Dinar is fixed to the dollar with 1USD = 0.376BHD. Credit cards are widely accepted and ATM's are plentiful.

The working week runs usually from Sunday to Thursday. Bahrain's numerous shopping malls are open very late, often past midnight on weekends.

Electricity

In Bahrain the power sockets are of type G. The standard voltage is 230 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz.
